

# **NIHR Research Delivery Network**

Configuration of the NIHR Regional Research Delivery Networks from April 2024

#### **Background and rationale**

The Department for Health and Social Care (DHSC) has agreed new geographic configurations for the future NIHR Research Delivery Network. New geographic configurations for the Regional Research Delivery Networks (RRDNs) will cover the whole country, with a national coordinating centre. Determinants included size of population, number of Trusts/Partner organisations, patient pathways, geographic area covered.

Alignment of the Network with the seven NHS England regions is considered vital. Integrated Care Systems (ICSs) and their component organisations will be crucial partners for the RDNs. The new configuration recognises the importance of our research in the NHS and the focus on social care and public health. ICSs are organised within NHSE regions, and local authorities mostly share boundaries with ICSs.


Note: The names of the new networks in this document are working titles and may change. The nomenclature for the new NIHR Regional Research Delivery Networks is yet to be confirmed.
